### JOB DESCRIPTION

### SPECIFIC NEEDS/REQUIREMENTS

- **Licensed Forensic of Surgical Pathologists (6).** Require SMEs who are trained and currently licensed forensic or surgical pathologists. Prefer experience with performing autopsies both on natural and unnatural expirations and determining cause and manner of death. Provides a broad range of mortuary services consistent with that of a forensic or surgical pathologist working in a mortuary setting.
- **Pathology Assistants (6).** Require individuals (either certified pathology assistants or forensic technicians) to assist the pathologist in performing autopsies including evisceration of the body and proper collection of specimens and photographing the body under the direction of the pathologist.
- **Forensic Dental Assistants (2).** Assist the on-site dentist with performing dental examinations for identification purposes including taking x-rays and dental charting.
- **Forensic Photographer (1).** Ability to photograph human remains in the morgue under the direction of the pathologist
- **Bilingual Medical Transcriptionist (1).** Ability to transcribe autopsies performed by pathologists; understanding of medical terminology and transcription computer skills. Must be bilingual and able to transcribe notes in both English and Spanish.
- **Forensic Team Coordinator (1).** Must be bi-lingual and be able to coordinate and troubleshoot complex issues and facilitate recovery planning coordination with the team and federal and Commonwealth government organizations. Requires five years of experience; understanding of mortuary terminology, programs, and processes; and ability to multi-task in a highly sensitive environment.
